Julie began studying piano at age four and violin at age eight. As a pianist, she won the Young Artists Competition and performed with the Amarillo Symphony at age 15.

Julie Morrison graduated from The University of Texas at Austin with a degree in piano performance (summa cum laude). Julie now performs regularly as violinist with The Rivendell Trio and in the symphony orchestras of Jackson and Germantown, Tennessee. She is married to Memphis Youth Symphony Music Director - Conductor Dr. Douglas Morrison.



Steven Byess is the Music Director of the Tupelo Symphony Orchestra, the Cover Conductor for the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, Opera Conductor for California State University — Los Angeles, Conductor at the International Vocal Arts Institute in Tel Aviv, Israel and the former Music Director of the Ohio Light Opera where he conducted, to critical acclaim, over 400 performances of 50 diverse operas, operettas, and musical theater works. Mr. Kocman served as treasurer of the Illinois Unit of the International Association of Jazz Educators and as vice-president of the Illinois Music Educators Association District 1 Jazz Division. He twice co-chaired the Illinois South Inter-Conference band activity and served as judge for the Illinois Music Educators Association All-State tryouts. Mr. Kocman played principal flute in the Chicago Heights Symphony Orchestra and performed with the Illinois Philharmonic Orchestra. He served as Director of Jazz Studies at Governors State University and was head judge at the Iowa Jazz Championships on many occasions.

Upon retirement in 2003, he joined the Prairie State College music faculty where he taught Musicology. Since moving to Tennessee in 2006, he performed with several ensembles, become director/member of the Bartlett Flute Choir and member of the Bartlett Community Concert Band. Martin holds memberships in the IMEA and MENC.

He received the Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in Wind Conducting in December of 2004.

In addition to his work with Jerry Junkin, Dr. Bianco has studied conducting with John Paynter, Kevin Sedatole and Steve Bolstad. His trumpet teachers have included Vincent Cichowicz, Ray Sasaki, Steve Bolstad, David Coleman and Vince DiMartino. Throughout his career Dr. Bianco has conducted ensembles in eight states and performed as a trumpet player in many others. Recent projects include a faculty performance of George Crumb's Songs, Drones and Refrains of Death, three publications in GIA's Teaching Music through Performance in Band, research into the works of Texas composer Donald Grantham that culminated in a lecture presentation at the 2006 CBDNA Southwest Regional Conference, an appearance with the Western Washington University Wind Ensemble at the 2008 WMEA conference in Yakima, WA and an appearance with the same group at the 2008 CBDNA Western Region Conference in Reno, Nevada. Christopher now holds the position of Director of Bands at Western Washington University. He resides in Bellingham, Washington with his wife Laurie and their daughters Sophia and Elena.


