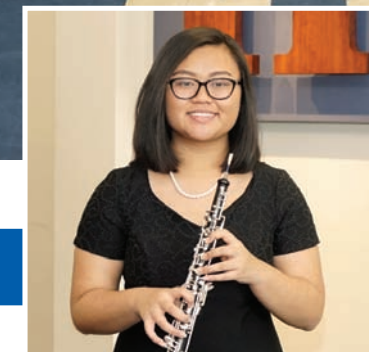

Kenneth D. Carroll presently serves as Associate Professor of Saxophone and Director of Jazz Studies at Arkansas State University. He earned the Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees for the University of Georgia where he studied saxophone with Kenneth M. Fischer and jazz with Roger Dancz. He earned the Bachelor of Arts in Music Education from Arkansas Tech University where he studied with Gene Witherspoon, Richard Fletcher and Hal Cooper.

An active proponent of America's Music: Jazz; Kenneth has performed and recorded with many of the major figures of the art. Recent recordings include Ellis Marsalis, Lou Marini, Tom Malone, Jiggs Wigham, the Birmingham SuperBand, Michael Medrick and many others. Kenneth's popular group, "Top Shelf", works consistently throughout the south and Midwest garnering praise for variety and entertainment.

The Jazz Studies program at Arkansas State is an obvious source of pride for the institution and community, including two large ensembles, four small groups and a vocal jazz group. The ASTATE Jazz Orchestra has been featured at the Clinton Presidential Library and prestigious jazz festivals. Recognized for outstanding soloists, graduates hold respected chairs in professional jazz groups, graduate assistantships, and educational institutions. Each season, numerous jazz arrangers create new music for the ensemble; including Chris Clark, Tom O'Connor, Michael Medrick, and Chris Ott.

Kenneth's current research focus is sound production and improvisation. An active digital arts producer, he works exclusively with the Reason software and plug-ins. For the past five years, Kenneth performs on the Akai EWI family of instruments, driving a host of computers, loopers, effects and voices designed by Matt Traum. Immersed in the past and living the future, Kenneth's musical interests span the bulk of recorded music with a primary focus on improvised musics.



Shawn 'Thunder' Wallace is a talented performer, recording artist, composer, clinician and educator, skilled in jazz music and equally comfortable with classical, contemporary christian and gospel music. He has been seen and heard nationally on CBS, BET, NBC and NPR. In addition to receiving recognition from many newspapers and publications including Billboard and Contemporary Christian Music Magazine, he is a winner of Downbeat magazine's outstanding soloist award.

Thunder is the Director of Jazz Studies and Associate Professor of Jazz Saxophone at The Ohio State University. He is also the Minister of Music and Worship Arts at Second Baptist Church. He has released 8 CD's, is a multi-instrumentalist (saxophone, flute, clarinet, piano, bass & guitar) and is the leader of Perfect Storm & The Shawn 'Thunder' Wallace Quartet. Thunder is a Vandoren Artist and endorses Gemeinhardt Musical Instruments. Thunder appeared in the movie "Miles Ahead" and is pursuing a DMA in Saxophone Performance at The University of Cincinnati (CCM).

Georgia Ekonomou has been a String Educator/Conductor for 39 years. She is the former Director of Orchestras at The Paideia School and The Lovett School. In January 2017, Ekonomou was awarded the "Georgia/ASTA Lifetime Achievement Award", in honor and recognition of her contribution to Musical Excellence in the state of Georgia. Ekonomou is the artistic director and conductor of the Emory Junior Chamber Orchestra at Emory University. Mrs. Ekonomou is a member of GMEA, ASTA, and NAFME and has served on the advisory committee for the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, and on the national Membership committee for ASTA. In July 2016, she was appointed Southern Division Representative to the NAFME Council for Orchestral Education.



Dr. Kevin F.E. Sütterlin is an internationally sought-after conductor, clinician, and pedagogue. A dedicated 21st century musician, Sütterlin is passionate about exploring new, non-traditional forms of musical experience. The German conductor has taught and performed across the globe including Austria, China, Germany, Italy, Romania, Slovenia, Switzerland and the United States. Most recently, he conducted the 2017 North Dakota State Orchestra Festival, and is the appointed conductor of the Minnesota All-State Symphony Orchestra 2018/19.

Sütterlin is Director of Orchestral Activities and Assistant Professor of Instrumental Conducting at Concordia College. He is Music Director and Conductor of The Concordia Orchestra and The Concordia Opera. Further, he is Co-Music Director and Conductor of Sinfonietta Memphis, as well as Artistic Director and Conductor of the Northern Valley Youth Orchestras. Sütterlin recently won third prize in the prestigious American Prize in Orchestral Conducting. He is an awardee of the Hirschmann Foundation scholarship of Switzerland, the University of Memphis International Research scholarship, and the University of Memphis Creative Achievement Award. Last year, the televised production of the Concordia Christmas Concerts 2016 received an Emmy.

Before joining the faculty at Concordia College in 2016, Sütterlin served The University of Memphis, Rudi E. Scheidt School of Music as Acting Music Director of the Chamber Orchestra, Acting Music Director of Opera, and Chief Assistant Conductor of the Symphony Orchestra.

Sütterlin received his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Orchestral Conducting as well as his Master of Music degree in Orchestral Conducting from The University of Memphis – Rudi E. Scheidt School of Music, and holds a Bachelor of Arts in Music in Instrumental Conducting with secondary majors in voice and piano from the Hochschule Luzern – Musik in Lucerne, Switzerland.

Captain Charles Harrison

Charles F. Harrison was born in Canton, Mississippi on January 8, 1895. At the age of ten Charles toured the United States with a concert band, performing on cornet. In 1917 he performed on baritone at Mississippi A&M, now known as Mississippi State University. In 1919, Charles Harrison directed a student band on the campus until completing his undergraduate degree in engineering. During World War I, he was assistant director of the army band stationed at Muscle Shoals.

In 1928 the Harrison's moved to Memphis and the following year Charles Harrison, Sr. was employed by the Melody Music Shop, a music store owned by Saul Bluestein at 13 South Main Street. Harrison's job at the Melody Music Shop was to organize new bands throughout the tri-state area and serve as a traveling band director. He was director of the band at Southwestern College (now Rhodes College) in Memphis and high-school bands in Marks and Lambert, New Albany, and Lula, Mississippi; and Memphis, Rosemark, Covington, and Millington, Tennessee. During this time, he also played lead trumpet in Malcolm Burk's Dance Band.

In September of 1931 the Christian Brothers Band was reorganized under the direction of Lieutenant Charles Harrison. The group rapidly developed into the largest and finest student organization in the school. The Christian Brothers held a great respect for Lieutenant Harrison. The Memphis high school band tradition for the 1920's was that of the Jazz Orchestra in the style of Jimmy Lunceford, and not one of marching or concert bands. Harrison encouraged his bands to follow the instrumentation



of the modern high school band. Christian Brother's student Lawrence Patrick Cooney, who would later become the Superintendent of Music in the Memphis City Schools, was a student of his during this time.

In the 1930s, the Cotton Carnival Parades were becoming the largest parades the city had ever seen. The largest band, of one hundred high school students, was led by Charles Harrison and was titled the Memphis Cotton Carnival Official Band.

Harrison also hosted a two-week summer band camps at the Memphis Fairgrounds with nightly public concerts. The camp eventually grew to over 300 students participating. He served as a bandmaster in the Mid-South until 1943 when he left Memphis, to serve in World War II. He returned a Captain to Memphis after the war and he conducted the ROTC Bands in Memphis. After 1947 he moved to Atlanta where he died on April 11, 1983.

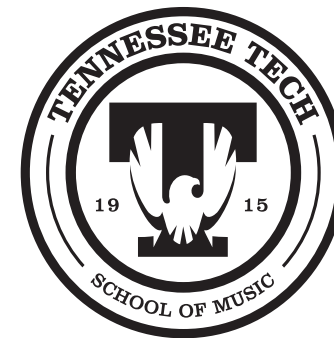

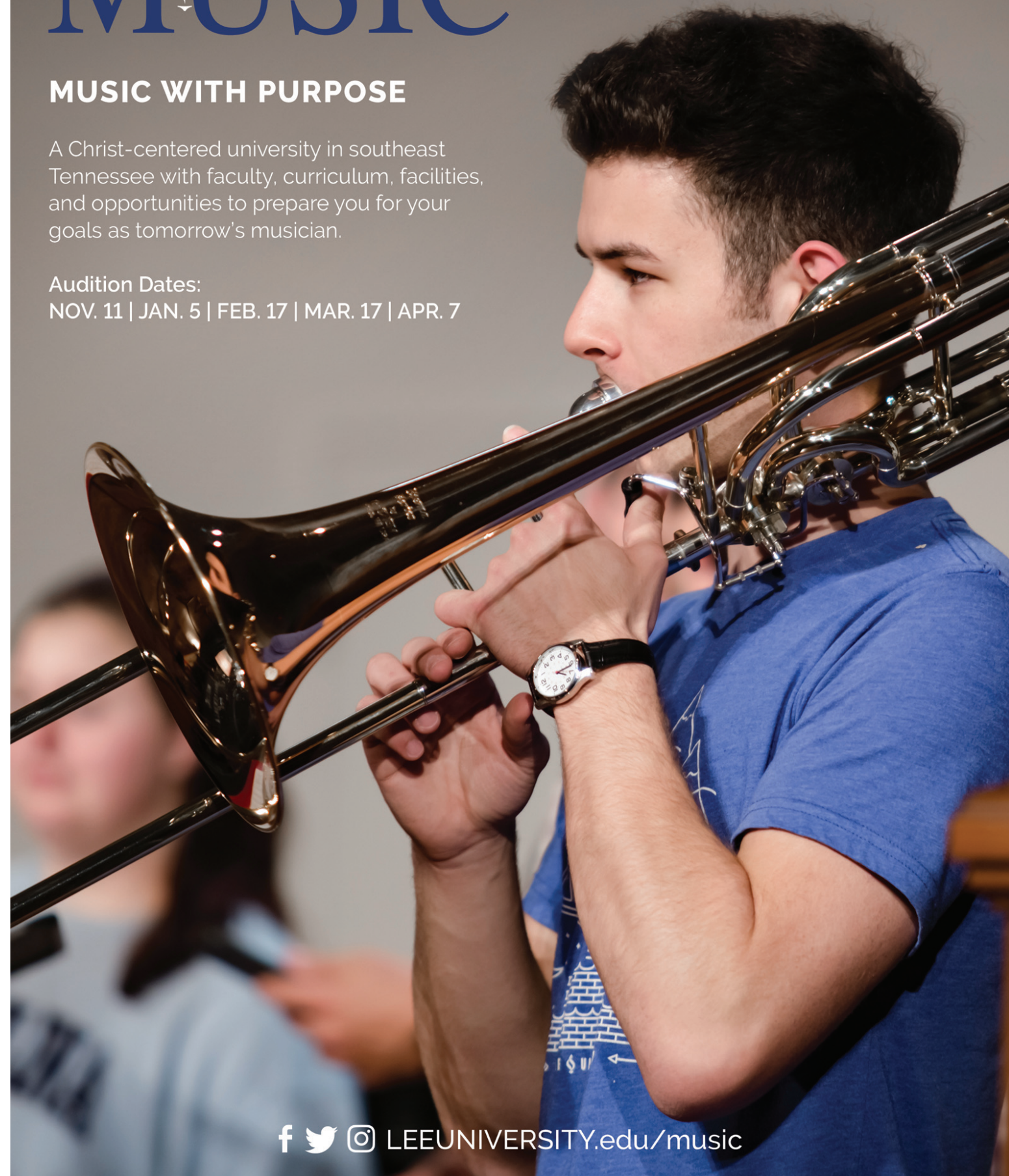
