

Jerry A. Bracey is an Assistant Professor of Music, Conductor of Hampton University Chamber Orchestra and Director of the HU Jazz Ensemble. He holds degrees from Jackson State University, Northeast Louisiana University, and studied conducting at the Nice Academic International

D'ete in Nice, France. While abroad, he studied conducting with Pierre Dervaux, Ferdinand Quaptocchi; and viola with Christos Michalakakos. Mr. Bracey currently serves as Coordinator of the Hampton University Music Enrichment Program for Youth (HUM), Instrumental Area Coordinator and Coordinator for the Annual Week of Jazz.

Prior to his arrival at Hampton University, he served as Director of Bands in Tensas Parish Public Schools. Under his guidance, the Jazz, Symphonic, Concert and Marching Bands received numerous awards, and superior ratings on the local, state and national level. He also served as Conductor of the Dougherty Country Youth Symphony Orchestra of Albany, Georgia.

Bracey is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity of America, Music Education National Conference (MENC)- (NAfME), American String Teachers Association with National School Orchestra Association (ASTA) and (NSOA), International Conductor Guild, Kappa Kappa Psi Honorary Band Fraternity and the College Orchestra Director Association.

Bracey's performance credits include appointments with the Jackson Symphony Orchestra, Mississippi Symphony, Greenville Symphony, South Arkansas Symphony Orchestra, Ruston Civic Orchestra, and the Opera/South Orchestra. He also served as Musical Director for Hampton University Little Theatre Productions of the Broadway show's GREASE, Smokey Joe's Café, DREAMGIRLS and Ain't Misbehavin.

Tony Baker has taught at the University of North Texas College of Music since 2000. Currently a member of the Dallas Opera Orchestra, he has performed with ensembles such as the Minnesota Opera Orchestra, the Dallas Symphony Orchestra, the Columbus Symphony Orchestra and the Akron Symphony Orchestra. In May 2016 Mr. Baker accepted an invitation of full membership in the Brass Band of Battle Creek. As a soloist, Mr. Baker has established an international reputation. Most recently he performed as guest clinician and artist at the University of Northern Iowa. He also performed as guest artist the the 2016 JEN conference, soloist at the 2015 American Trombone Workshop in Ft. Myer, VA and the 2015 International Trombone Festival in Valencia, Spain. Ensembles with which Mr. Baker has performed as soloist include the United States Army Band "Pershing's Own", the Ohio Valley Symphony and the University of North Texas Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Baker has given guest recitals and/or master classes at schools such as the Cedros-Panamerican University (Mexico), Federal University of São João (Brazil), The Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester (UK) and Trinity College of Music in London. Mr. Baker's students have won positions with institutions such as the Vienna Philharmonic, the United States Army Blues Jazz Band, the United States Coast Guard Band and most recently the United States Army Jazz Ambassadors.














Deborah Baker Monday received her B.M.E., from Florida State University with an emphasis in string education. She was awarded an academic fellowship to attend the University of Alabama where she received her M.M. in composition. During that time, she was a bassist with the Meridian Symphony Orchestra and the Tupelo Symphony Orchestra. She continued her studies at Louisiana State University where she received the Chancellor's Award to participate in the Symphony Orchestra under the direction of James Yestadt. She has studied theory and composition with Harold Schiffman, John Boda, Frederic Goossen, Paul Hedwall and Dinos Constantinides

Ms. Monday continued to be an active bass. After completing all of the course work and passing the written and oral portions of the doctoral exams, she was hired to teach in the Logan City School District as a low string specialist. During her tenure with Logan she has pursued her interest in composition and arranging for educational strings and has over 130 works with seven publishing companies. She has received awards for Outstanding Elementary Educator and Superior Accomplishment from the UtahASTA and UtahMEA, respectively. She won the UtahASTA Composition Competition in 2006 and 2011.

Ms. Monday has presented at numerous state music conferences throughout the U.S. as well as several national ASTA conventions, The Midwest Clinic and the prestigious Ohio State String Teachers Workshop. She is very active as a clinician, conductor and adjudicator and has received numerous commissions for her work. Her studies in composition and experience in string education have combined to make her one of the leading contributors to the educational repertoire for string players.



A 1983 graduate of The University of Tennessee at Martin, John D. Easley retired in 2016 after 34 years as a public school band director in the state of Tennessee. His longest tenure was with the Union City School System as Director of Bands for 31 yrs., where the band program boasted membership of approximately 38 percent of the student population.

Under Mr. Easley's direction, the band program flourished, affording his students much success, both individually and collectively. A nationally recognized program, the Union City High School Marching Band is a 5-time Tennessee Division II State Champion, as well as the winner of 10 Bands of America Regional and Super Regional Class Championships, and an 8 time finalist at the prestigious Contest of Champions at Middle Tn. State University. In 2016, he and his wife were chosen to lead the Union City Rotary Club's European Travel Study tour for 8 high school students.

Mr. Easley's professional affiliations include Phi Beta Mu professional band director fraternity (past president); WTSBOA (past president); Tennessee Music Educators Association (past board member); American School Band Director Association, and Tennessee Bandmasters Association.

Additionally, he credits his father, the late George Easley, a Navy musician, with encouraging him to follow his dream of becoming a music educator.

Mr. Easley is currently the Middle Tennessee Educational Consultant for Amro Music and he and Delana reside in Smyrna, Tn.


