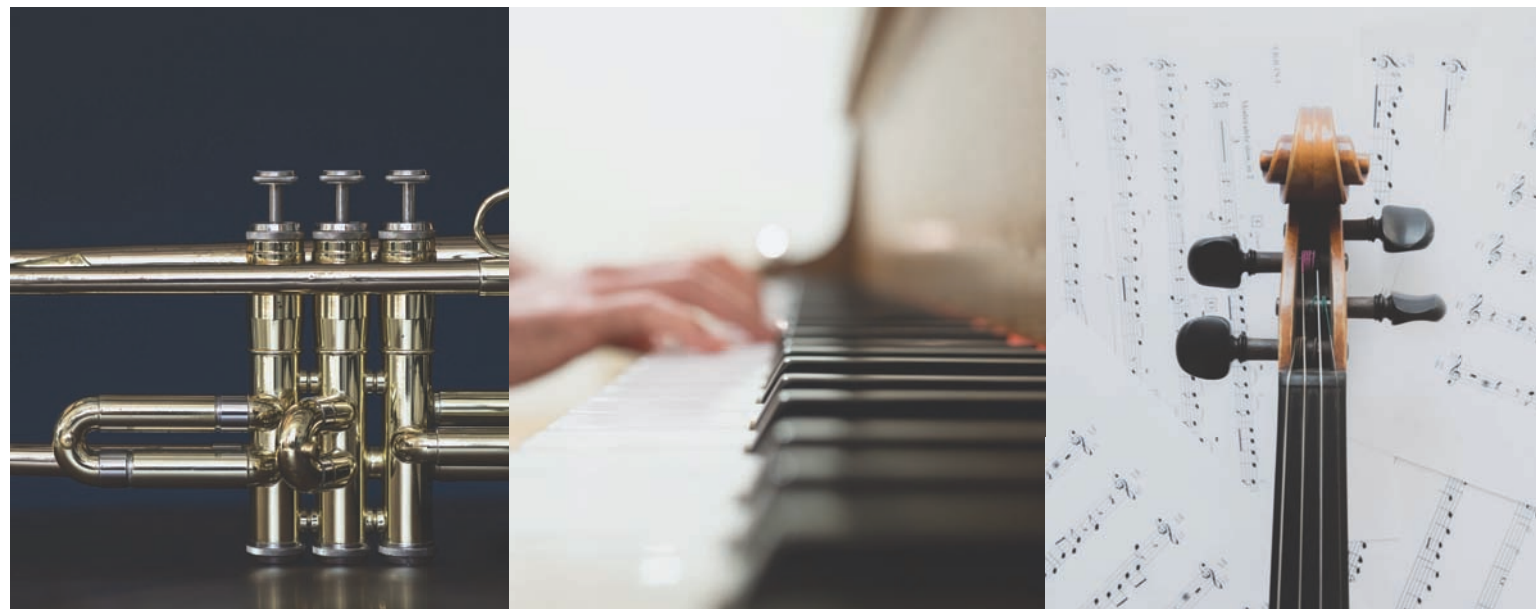

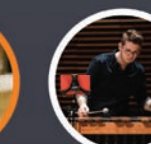

Jerry A. Bracey is an Assistant Professor of Music, Conductor of Hampton University Chamber Orchestra and Director of the HU Jazz Ensemble. He holds degrees from Jackson State University, Northeast Louisiana University, and studied conducting at the Nice Academic International D'ete in Nice, France. While abroad, he studied conducting with Pierre Dervaux, Ferdinand Quapocchi; and viola with Christos Michalakakos. Mr. Bracey currently serves as Coordinator of the Hampton University Music Enrichment Program for Youth (HUM), Instrumental Area Coordinator and Coordinator for the Annual Week of Jazz.

Prior to his arrival at Hampton University, he served as Director of Bands in Tensas Parish Public Schools. Under his guidance, the Jazz, Symphonic, Concert and Marching Bands received numerous awards, and superior ratings on the local, state and national level. He also served as Conductor of the Dougherty Country Youth Symphony Orchestra of Albany, Georgia.

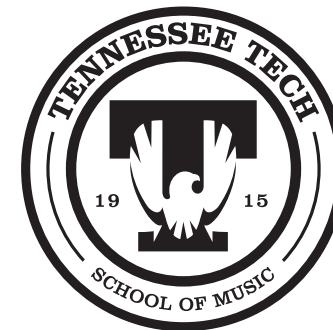

## John D. Easley

A 1983 graduate of The University of Tennessee at Martin, John D. Easley retired in 2016 after 34 years as a public school band director in the state of Tennessee. His longest tenure was with the Union City School System as Director of Bands for 31 yrs., where the band program boasted membership of approximately 38 percent of the student population.

Under Mr. Easley's direction, the band program flourished, affording his students much success, both individually and collectively. A nationally recognized program, the Union City High School Marching Band is a 5-time Tennessee Division II State Champion, as well as the winner of 10 Bands of America Regional and Super Regional Class Championships, and an 8 time finalist at the prestigious Contest of Champions at Middle Tn. State University. They have been accepted and marched in The Tournament of Roses Parade, The Sunkist Fiesta Bowl Parade, Disney Days Celebration, and most recently, the St. Patrick's Day Parade in New York City. In 2005 and 2009, the UCHS Symphonic Band performed a full concert on the deck of the USS Missouri in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.

In addition to his work with his own bands, John is consistently sought out as a consultant, clinician, workshop presenter, and adjudicator throughout the Southeast. One of the highlights of his career includes his time as a staff member with the United States Army All-American Band in San Antonio, Texas.

John has always taken an active role in his community, having served as the Sanctuary Choir Director at First United Methodist Church from 1997 to 2017. He has also been an active participant in the community's Masquerade Theatre, both as actor and pit orchestra member, and most recently as President of the Masquerade Theatre Board of Directors. "Coach Easley" has worked with numerous children and young adults in the Little League, Babe Ruth, and girls' softball leagues in Union City and Obion County. In 2016, he and his wife were chosen to lead the Union City Rotary Club's European Travel Study tour for 8 high school students.

Mr. Easley's professional affiliations include Phi Beta Mu professional band director fraternity (past president); WTSBOA (past president); Tennessee Music Educators Association (past board member); American School Band Director Association, and Tennessee Bandmasters Association.

Originally from Union City, TN, John would like to thank the late Mr. Marion Reithel for inspiring him as an outstanding educator, mentor, and friend. Additionally, he credits his father, the late George Easley, a Navy musician, with encouraging him to follow his dream of becoming a music educator.

John is married to Delana Easley, former UTM Faculty Collaborative Pianist. They have been blessed with a wonderful family, all of whom are involved in music and the performing arts: Benjamin and Sarah Easley, Benjamin is Director of Bands at Nolensville High School, daughters Ella and Harper; Rebecca and Chris Lowry, Rebecca is Director of Bands at Mill Creek Middle School and Chris is Associate Director of Bands at Rockvale High School; and Andrew Easley. Mr. Easley is currently the Middle Tennessee Educational Consultant for Amro Music and he and Delana reside in Smyrna, Tn.

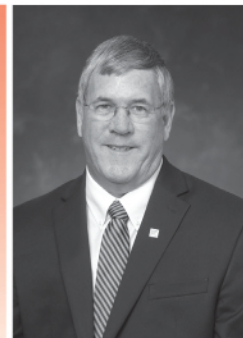

Steven R. Barnett is currently in his first year as the Director of Athletic Bands at the University of Tennessee at Martin and his 41st year in education. Prior to joining the music department at UT Martin, Mr. Barnett worked as Coordinator of the UTM Office of Educational Outreach and served the bands of West Tennessee as an Educational Representative for Amro Music. Prior to moving back home to West Tennessee, Barnett was Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Marshall University for eleven years. In 2012, Barnett received the Marshall and Shirley Reynolds Teacher of the Year Award, one of the highest awards that a faculty member may receive at Marshall University and was also nominated by Marshall University as the CASE Council National Teacher of the Year for 2012-2013.

Mr. Barnett received a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Mississippi and a Masters of Music Education degree from Mississippi College. In addition to Marshall University, he has previously held band directing positions in Mississippi at the University of Mississippi, Copiah-Lincoln Community College, Madison, Forest, Oxford, Newton and Pearl High School. While Director of Bands at Copiah-Lincoln Community College, he received the HEADWAE Award for the most outstanding instructor and was honored by the Mississippi State Legislature.

Mr. Barnett is an active guest conductor and clinician throughout the U.S. and is currently a staff arranger for Jalen Publishing Company of Orlando, FL where he currently has 15 marching band arrangements published.



Dr. Clifton Taylor has served as Associate Director of Bands at Mississippi State University since 2005. At MSU, he co-directs the Famous Maroon Band and basketball pep bands, conducts the MSU Symphonic Band and the Jazz Ensemble, and teaches courses in the Department of Music. A native of Mississippi, he holds two music education degrees from the University of Southern Mississippi, and a DMA in wind conducting from the University of South Carolina. A veteran teacher, Dr. Taylor has taught instrumental music at every level, from the elementary school to the community college, and currently directs the band program for the Starkville Homeschool Music Cooperative.

Dr. Taylor is regularly engaged in composing and arranging for concert band, marching band, and other media. He arranges many of the pieces performed by the Famous Maroon Band, and he has served as the wind arranger for the Mississippi Lions All State Band since 2014. His original concert band works are published by Grand Mesa Music Publishers, TapSPACE Publications, and his own Maroon Tune Publications.

As a trombonist, Dr. Taylor performs in symphonic, jazz, and chamber settings. He has been the principal trombonist of the Meridian Symphony since 2002. He is affiliated with the College Band Directors National Association; the National Band Association; the Mississippi Bandmasters Association; Phi Beta Mu; Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia; Kappa Kappa Psi; and the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers.

A native of Tuskegee, Alabama, she holds degrees from the University of Alabama and the University of Southern Mississippi. Dr. Rhoden was named the NAfME 2018 National Band Director of the Year, has been awarded the National Band Association's Citation of Excellence on four occasions, has been named STAR Teacher and Teacher of the Year, and was presented the 1995 Sallie Mae First Class Teacher Award, a national award given to one teacher in each state for an outstanding first year of teaching.

Dr. Rhoden has been selected for presentations at The Midwest Clinic, Music for All Summer Symposium, VanderCook College of Music MECA Continuing Education Program, the Youth Orchestra of LA at the Heart of Los Angeles, the Wyoming and Georgia Music Educators Association Conferences, and various schools and camps throughout the country. She has had the distinct pleasure of being a guest conductor for The United States Army Field Band of Washington, D. C. and the Tara Winds of Atlanta, Georgia. She is the founder of the Athena Music and Leadership Camp (athenacamp.com), an all-girls band/orchestra summer camp that was created to promote musical excellence while emphasizing leadership and team-building skills. She is also honored to be a Conn-Selmer Educational Clinician and a member of the Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. She resides in Fayetteville, Georgia with her husband, Errol Jr., and son, Errol III.
