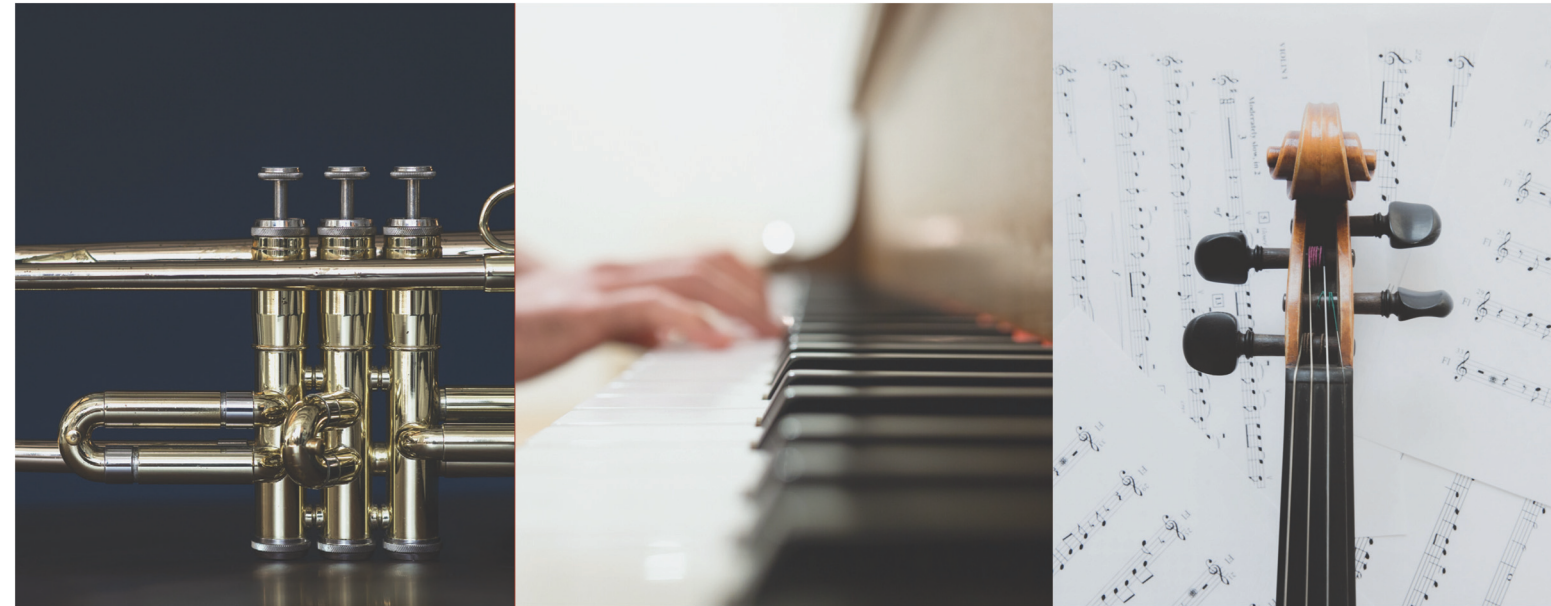

Jim Ketch is Professor Emeritus of Music and the past Director of Jazz Studies for the Department of Music, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He retired on July 1, 2020 having spent 43 years teaching trumpet, directing the UNC Jazz Band and Jazz Combos. He has conducted all state and regional honors jazz bands in North and South Carolina, Virginia, New Hampshire, Nebraska, Louisiana, Florida, Alabama, and Tennessee. He was the recipient of four teaching awards during his tenure at UNC and spent 3 years as Chair of the Department of Music. At his retirement, Ketch was presented with a plaque, issued by North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper, inducting him into The Order of the Long Leaf Pine.

A versatile trumpeter, Mr. Ketch has recorded four CDs on the Summit and Crystal Records label. He serves as trumpeter and/or Music Director on three recordings of the North Carolina Jazz Repertory Orchestra and four recordings of the UNC Jazz Band. Additional recording projects have included dates with the Mint Julep Jazz Band, the Gregg Gelb Swing Band, the Piedmont Wind Symphony, and on the jazz CD Carolina Tracks. He has performed and or conducted across the US and in England, France, Switzerland, and the Netherlands. He has shared the stage with numerous jazz and classical artists including Branford Marsalis, Marcus Roberts, Rene Marie, Manhattan Transfer, Aretha Franklin, the Temptations, the Four Tops, John Pizzarelli, William Warfield, Robert Shaw, the Summit Brass, and the North Carolina Symphony.

Mr. Ketch served with Marcus Roberts for 15 years as Associate Director of Swing Central Jazz for the Savannah Music Festival. He is the founder of the Carolina Jazz Festival (1977) which has collaborated for 18 years with Jazz at Lincoln Center to offer the annual North Carolina Regional Essentially Ellington High School Jazz Festival. Ketch continues to serve (20+ years) on the faculty of the Jamey Aebersold Summer Jazz Workshop in Louisville, KY.

Mr. Ketch and his wife Susan reside in Durham, NC with Quincy the dog! They have two daughters Katie and Megan, and four grandchildren, Lily, Graham, Oliver, and Leon!

Ronald Carter – Former Distinguished Professor, UNC-Fayetteville State University. Carter is former director of the world-renowned Northern Illinois University (NIU) Jazz Ensemble. As an educator, Carter has presented workshops as guest conductor, artist, clinician, or adjudicator throughout the United States. He has performed, conducted and presented clinics at regional, national, and international conferences, and directed numerous all-state jazz bands. Carter conducted the Florida State University Tri - State All-Star Jazz Band.

Carter who worked 18 years in the East St. Louis School District as the former director of the Lincoln Senior High School Jazz Band, also performed professionally in the St. Louis metropolitan area as a freelance musician on saxophone, clarinet, flute, and as a vocalist. He co-directed the group Infiti and performed with the legendary George Hudson Orchestra. Carter has also performed professionally with Clark Terry, Jimmy Heath, Lena Horne, Lou Rawls, The Jimmy Dorsey Band, Wallace Roney, The Temptations, The Dells, Oliver Lake, Hamiett Bluiett, Leon Thomas, Art Davis, Fareed Haque, Joseph Bowie, Frank Mantooth, Terrell Stafford, Orbert Davis, Carl Allen, Rodney Whitaker, and many others.

An abbreviated list of his honors and awards includes Downbeat Magazine's Jazz Educators Hall of Fame, The Woody Herman Music Award, The 1991 Milken National Distinguished Educator Award, Southern Illinois University Excellence in Teaching Award, and the St. Louis American Newspaper's Excellence in Teaching Award and Northern Illinois University Board of Trustees Professorship. Carter accepted appointment as Felton J. Capel Distinguished Professor of Performing and Fine Arts UNC – Fayetteville State University, Fayetteville, NC, 2018-2020, 2021 HBCU – National Band Director's Consortium Lifetime Achievement Award, 2022 Conn-Selmer Lifetime Achievement Award, 2022 Medal of Honor from Midwest Clinic. Carter's projects include former vice-president International Association of Jazz Educators, former Carter's projects include former vice-president International Association of Jazz Educators, former International Consultant for the Essentially Ellington Jazz Competition sponsored by Jazz at Lincoln Center in New York; former Lead Artist for the Jazz At Lincoln Center Band Director's Academy; Co-Author for Alfred Publications "Swingin' On The Bars", and co-author of GIA Music Publications "Teaching Music Through Performance in Jazz – Book I & II as well as a contributing author to the Beginning Jazz Ensemble Textbook. Carter is currently working on Volume III of "Teaching Music Through Performance in Jazz." He recently started a new business with former students from around the world, "Carter's Jazz Clinics LLC" promoting a cultural approach to teaching all aspects of jazz and Afro-American music.

Carter is currently an artist for Conn-Selmer Inc., Education Consultant for Conn-Selmer Inc. and artist for D'Addario Woodwinds – (Rico Reeds).

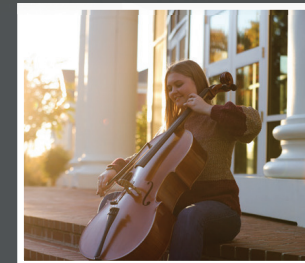
