



After earning an undergraduate degree in music education from George Peabody College in 1977, Dr. Richard Ripani embarked on a career as a professional musician. As a performer, he has many accomplishments to his credit, including numerous recording sessions in Nashville studios. Among these recordings are one double-platinum and two gold albums. As a live music performer, he has played with and/or conducted orchestras for several national-level musical artists across North America and Europe. During the 1980s, Mr. Ripani also acted as orchestra conductor at the Aladdin, Riviera, and Nugget Hotels in Las Vegas and Reno, Nevada. TV programs on which he has performed include: Tonight Show with Johnny Carson, Tonight Show with Jay Leno, Mike Douglas Show, Merv Griffin Show, Austin City Limits, and Nashville Now, among many others.

More recently, his music studies continued at Austin Peay State University, MM in instrumental conducting (1997), and at the University of Memphis where he completed a PhD in Musicology/Ethnomusicology (2004). His book, The New Blue Music: Changes in Rhythm & Blues, 1950-1999, is published by the University Press of Mississippi and is currently held in the libraries of over 1000 colleges and universities, worldwide. In May of 2004, while an assistant professor of music at Cumberland University, he was selected to receive the President's Award for Teaching Excellence.

From 2005-2019, his career continued at Hume-Fogg Academic High School in Nashville and included directing the concert bands and jazz bands, as well as teaching AP music theory. His jazz groups at Hume-Fogg were some of the most awarded in Tennessee, having been selected on three occasions to serve as featured guest performers at the Tennessee Music Educators Association (TMEA) Conference.

For the last few years, Dr. Ripani has served as an adjunct music history professor at Belmont University, while also directing the newly established Nashville Youth Jazz Ensemble, a non-profit organization whose mission is to provide a high-quality jazz big band experience for students 14-18 throughout the Nashville area, while at the same time helping to foster a greater appreciation for jazz music in the greater Nashville community. Dr. Ripani is a highly sought-after jazz clinician throughout the southeastern United States, and he is a member of numerous professional organizations.

Dr. Todd E. Hill is Professor of Music and Director of Jazz Studies at Murray State University in Murray, Kentucky. In his thirty-seventh year of teaching, he directs the MSU Jazz Orchestra, Jazz Band, Jazz Combos. Under his leadership, the MSU Jazz Orchestra has played at numerous state conferences, won "Outstanding Big Band Performance" through regular appearances at the famed Elmhurst College Jazz Festival, and performed at the prestigious Mid-West International Band Clinic. The group presently has five albums available for purchase or streaming on all major platforms.

Dr. Hill founded both the MSU Jamey Aebersold Jazz Festival (2007) and the MSU Town & Gown Community Band (2012). As a free-lance pianist, he has performed with Doc Severinsen, Bob Hope, Frank Sinatra, Jr., Gary Morris, Denise LaSalle, Stella Parton, The Moody Blues, Byron Stripling, Allen Vizzutti, Chris Vadala, Ron Wilkins, Jamey Aebersold, Denis Dißlasio, Buddy Childers, Greg Abate, Rich Matteson, and the Paducah (KY) and Jackson (TN) Symphony Orchestras. His compositions and arrangements for tuba-euphonium ensemble and trombone choir are published by Cimarron Music. His arrangements for jazz band are published by Walrus Music through eJazzLines.

Dr. Hill was honored by the Kentucky Music Educators Association as "2016 College-University Teacher of the Year." He was awarded "College/University Music Educator of the Year" and "Friend of Music" five times by multiple KMEA Districts, served for four years on KMEA's Executive Board, and was named outstanding member of the MSU Music Faculty in 2015. He holds Bachelor and Master of Music Education degrees from Murray State University and the Doctor of Education (EdD) in Curriculum and Instruction (Music Education and School Reform) from Boise State University. Hill has been active as guest clinician and conductor for regional and all-state concert and jazz bands in Kentucky, Tennessee, Mississippi, Illinois, Arkansas, Missouri, Ohio, Idaho, Indiana, Washington, Montana, Oregon, and Nevada. Dr. Hill is a member of ASCAP, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Sigma Alpha lota (Friend of the Arts), Phi Beta Mu, Kappa Kappa Psi, NAFME, KMEA, ITEA, JEN, and the CBDNA. He is the Director of the Chancel Choir and Traditional Worship at First United Methodist Church in Murray, Kentucky.

Dr. Rodriguez served as Artistic Director for the national youth symphony orchestra representing the "Sistema" in Costa Rica. His background as a jazz pianist brings a unique and intimate perspective to his musical interpretations and he collaborates with musicians with a clear sense of purpose and intention, yet is profoundly respectful of the dignity and humanity that each person represents within the orchestra. Phrase and detail, emotive, energetic and purposeful, these are the characteristics that make him so compelling on the podium.

Gil Rollins started playing trombone in the 6th grade at Milan Middle School, under the direction of Mr. Robert Hodge. Mr. Rollins continued playing trombone in Milan High School and upon graduation, enrolled at the University of Tennessee at Martin as a Music Education Major. While student teaching, he met his soon to be wife, Leah Jean Moss. Gil began his career as the band director at Huntingdon High School in 1986. Within six years, and much perseverance, he took a struggling band program and doubled its size, increased school and community support, and won numerous awards. Under Mr. Rollins direction, the Huntingdon High School Band won the Fish Fry Parade, Strawberry Festival Parade, received numerous Superior ratings at WTSBOA Concert Festival, Excellent and Superior Ratings for students at Solo and Ensemble, and numerous students were selected into All-West and All-State. His hard work culminated in 1991 when the Huntingdon High School Band won the Tennessee State Division 1 Marching Band Championship.

In the fall of 1992, Gil was named head band director at Gibson County High School, turning that program around as well. The Gibson County High School Band won numerous superior ratings at the WTSBOA Concert Festival and had a majority of the band participate in Solo and Ensemble and receive Superior ratings. Several students were selected to the All-West and All-State Bands, and the marching band won two Division 2 State Championships in a row.

Upon receiving a Master's in Curriculum and Instruction from UT Martin and his 30 and above Masters in Educational Leadership from Freed-Hardeman University, Mr. Rollins took a leadership role at Gibson County Special School District Central Office in 1995. After a few years in administration, Mr. Rollins decided to go back into the band room in 1999 at Gibson County High School where the band won the Division 2 State Championship, again. In 2001, he accepted an administrative position at Trenton Special School District Central Office, where he served the schools of Trenton for 5 years.

In 2006, Gil found that he was missing the students and making music, so he accepted the job as Head Band Director at Peabody High School. Under his direction, Peabody placed higher than they ever had at the Division 2 State Championship and received all Superior Ratings at the WTSBOA Concert Festival. Mr. Rollins then took the Head Band Director job at Northside High School Band in 2007 and at Northeast Middle School in 2008. During his time at Northeast Middle, Gil focused on creating a strong feeder program for Northside High School.

In 2014, Mr. Rollins retired from teaching to return to administration. He served as the Transportation Director of Milan Special School District and then as Transportation Director of Trenton Special School District, where he stayed until his retirement in 2023. During this time, Gil was able to watch his two girls grow and he and his wife, Leah Jean supported them in the band program. Since his retirement, Gil and Leah Jean enjoy traveling to visit their two daughters.

Over Gil's illustrious career, he had 15 students that went on to major in music or become music educators. Several students are very active in WTSBOA and now have bands and band students that have been successful throughout the years. These students are carrying on his legacy to love music and to pour one's heart and soul into every student, while giving them the tools to succeed in music, as well as in life. These students have gone on to produce music educators of their own...continuing Mr. Rollins legacy.

Melissa Gustafson-Hinds is in her 17th year as Director of Bands at O'Fallon Township High School in O'Fallon, Illinois. In addition to her teaching duties at O'Fallon Township High School, Dr. Gustafson-Hinds serves as Performing Arts Department Chair at OTHS, the Illinois Music Educators Association Band Division President, and a High School Representative on the 2024-2026 National Band Association Board of Directors. She is also a recent inductee into the American Bandmasters Association. The OTHS Band Program has recently earned the honors of the John Philip Sousa Sudler Flag of Honor (2022) and the Sudler Shield (2023). 





