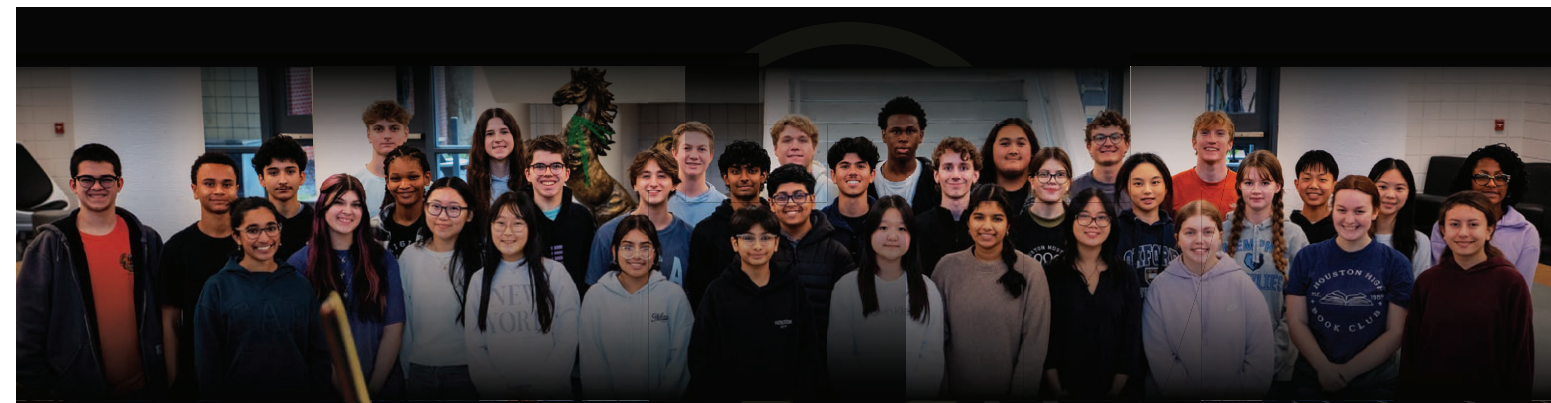

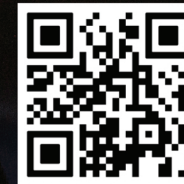

She earned her degree from Belmont University, where she studied under the mentorship of Tracy Silverman and Sarah Cote. Her time at Belmont was filled with unique opportunities—learning from Tammy Rogers-King of The SteelDrivers, performing in a jazz septet, and participating in a workshop with Yo-Yo Ma—all of which shaped her belief in making music accessible, engaging, and meaningful for all students. Brianne began her teaching career in Memphis, Tennessee, learning from some of the most accomplished string educators in the country. In March 2025, her students were selected to perform at the National American String Teachers Association Conference. She currently teaches fifth through twelfth grade orchestra in Springfield, Missouri, where she lives with her husband and three children.



Dr. Jean Gómez is a Costa Rican conductor, violist, and educator recognized for his dynamic leadership and expressive musicianship. As Director of Orchestral Activities at the University of Evansville, he leads the UE Symphony Orchestra and teaches courses in conducting and music appreciation. His work reflects a deep commitment to artistic excellence and student engagement.

Dr. Gómez began his musical training at the Escuela Municipal de Música de Paraíso and the Sistema Nacional de Educación Musical in Costa Rica. He later earned dual master's degrees in orchestral conducting and viola performance from Truman State University, followed by a Doctor of Musical Arts in ensemble conducting with a minor in piano from the University of Georgia.

An active performer and clinician, Dr. Gómez has conducted and performed throughout Central America, Mexico, Uruguay, Italy, and the United States. He has worked under the mentorship of renowned conductors including Dr. Diego Piedra, Dr. Sam McClure, Mark Cedel, Carl St. Clair, Osmo Vänskä, and Benjamin Zander. In 2019, he was awarded first place at the International Conductors Workshop and Competition in Atlanta, and he has twice been named a finalist for The American Prize in Orchestral Conducting.

In addition to his academic role, Dr. Gómez performs regularly as a violist with regional ensembles and is dedicated to strengthening musical communities through collaborations, outreach, and education.

Dr. Jeremy L. George is the Director of Jazz Studies and Assistant Professor of Music at Huston-Tillotson University in Austin, Texas. Since joining the faculty, he has revitalized the jazz program, leading the Huston-Tillotson Jazz Orchestra to two national competition victories and elevating the university's profile on the national stage.

A native of Florida, Dr. George earned his B.S. in Music Education from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University under the guidance of Dr. Julian E. White and Dr. Shelby Chipman. He went on to complete both his M.M.E. and Ph.D. in Music Education at Florida State University, where his dissertation, "A Firm Foundation: Examining the Influence of Black Gospel Music on Jazz Pedagogy," reflected his commitment to exploring the cultural foundations of jazz education. His mentors include Professor Rodney Jordan, Professor Leon Anderson, and Dr. Clifford Madsen.

Before his tenure at Huston-Tillotson, Dr. George served as a public-school music educator for 10 years, most notably as Director of Bands at James S. Rickards High School in Tallahassee, Florida. Under his leadership, the band program earned consistent superior ratings at the district and state levels, and he was awarded the Tom Bishop Award by the Florida Bandmasters Association in 2018.

An active performer, Dr. George is a freelance bassist who has shared the stage with Grammy Award-winning artists including Ledisi, Samara Joy, Wycliffe Gordon, and Andre Hayward. He is also a Conn Selmer Educational Artist, Southwest Representative for the NAFME Council for Jazz Education, and a faculty member of the Austin Youth Jazz Orchestra.



Joseph L. Jefferson is an award-winning educator, performer, and scholar recognized for his versatility and leadership in music. He currently serves as associate professor of music and director of jazz ensembles at St. Olaf College, where he also teaches applied jazz and commercial trombone.

Drawing from both the jazz and classical traditions to inform his artistry, Jefferson is an accomplished soloist and chamber musician whose performances span jazz, symphonic and commercial styles on national and international stages. He has performed with a wide range of artists and ensembles, including Vanessa Williams, Sean Jones, Catherine Russell, the Cab Calloway Orchestra, The Irish Tenors, and R&B artists Dwele and Raheem DeVaughn.

Widely recognized for his impact as a music educator, Jefferson was named one of Yamaha's "40 Under 40" in 2023 and received the Ellis Marsalis Jr. Jazz Educator of the Year Award from the Jazz Education Network in 2022. His academic contributions include research on the Shout Band tradition and publications such as *The Art of Jazz Programming*. Jefferson's students and ensembles have earned national and international recognition, including finalist placements in solo competitions and honorable mentions abroad.

A sought-after clinician and guest conductor, Jefferson regularly works with Jazz at Lincoln Center and recently served as a judge for the 30th anniversary of the Essentially Ellington Jazz Festival, one of the most prestigious high school jazz competitions in the United States. He has presented and performed at major conferences and festivals, including the Texas Music Educators Association Convention, Florida Music Educators Association Convention, the International Trombone Festival, the Lionel Hampton Jazz Festival and the Reno Jazz Festival.

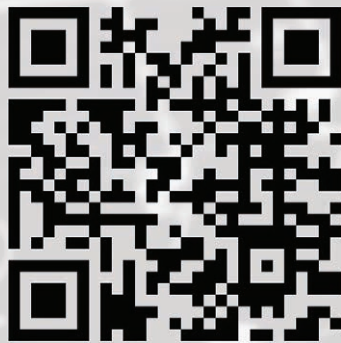
Jefferson holds degrees from Norfolk State University (B.M.), Shenandoah Conservatory (M.M.), and West Virginia University (D.M.A.).

DAVID E. CHIPMAN

...served 31 years as a full-time music educator. He served as a band director in the Memphis school system for two years, twenty-five years as Director of Bands, Music Dept. Chair and IB Music instructor at Bolton High School and four years as Director of Bands and IB music teacher at Germantown HS. The Bolton and Germantown band programs consistently earned superior ratings at marching and concert festival assessments. The concert ensembles also earned superior awards at national concert festival events. Both programs also earned The TBA Sweepstakes Award (multiple) and the ASBDA Award of Distinction in Concert Performance. Each year, a high percentage of students were chosen for the All-West TN honor bands and the All-State instrumental ensembles.

Since retirement, Mr. Chipman has served as an adjunct faculty member in the Rudi Scheidt School of Music at The University of Memphis, teaching music education and intro to music courses. Additionally, he teaches low brass private lessons in the Shelby County area and serves as a low brass and full band instructor/consultant to the Arlington, Collierville and Germantown school systems. Mr. Chipman has served as Orchestra Director at Faith Baptist Bartlett since 2021. He is also Bass Trombonist for the Memphis Wind Symphony and Bluff City Wind Ensemble.

A native Memphian, Mr. Chipman is an honor graduate of Overton High School and the University of Memphis. While at U of M, he was a member of 'The Mighty Sound of The South' Marching Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble (playing trombone and euphonium) Trombone Choir, Brass Ensemble and the 'Southern Comfort' Jazz Ensemble. His major professors included: Dr. Charles Schulz and the late Dr. Sidney J. McKay, Dr. Douglas C. Lemmon, Professors Tim Goodwin, Gene Rush and Arthur Theil.

Mr. Chipman has served on staff for the Tennessee Ambassadors of Music, 2017 European tour where he conducted concert band performances in England, France, Switzerland, Austria and Germany. During the 2024 TAM tour, he served as low brass instructor as well as the principal photographer, videographer and social media coordinator. Mr. Chipman's professional affiliations include National Association for Music Education (NAfME), International Assoc. for Jazz Education (IAJE), International Trombone Association (ITA), National Band Association, Tennessee Music

Education Association (TnMEA), Tennessee Bandmasters Association (TBA), West TN School Band and Orchestra Association (WTSBOA) and Tennessee Education Association. He has also been inducted into the prestigious American School Band Director Association (ASBDA) and Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. Mr. Chipman served WTSBOA as a senior band rehearsal chair for 10 years, served on the Executive Board for six years and Technology and Event Data Chair for 23 years. He also served on the TnMEA Board of Directors as State Band Chair for two years. Additional service was as Fine Arts Portfolio Reviewer for the Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE) and a member of the SCS Fine Arts Leadership Council.

Mr. Chipman and his wife Dr. Carol King-Chipman, also a retired band director in the Shelby County School System, have been married for 38 years and have one child, Ben, who recently graduated from the University of Memphis. Mr. and Dr. Chipman were recognized in 2009 with the Thomas P. Westendorf Award by the Bartlett TN Arts Council for their many years of service in music education to the Bartlett, TN community where they reside.

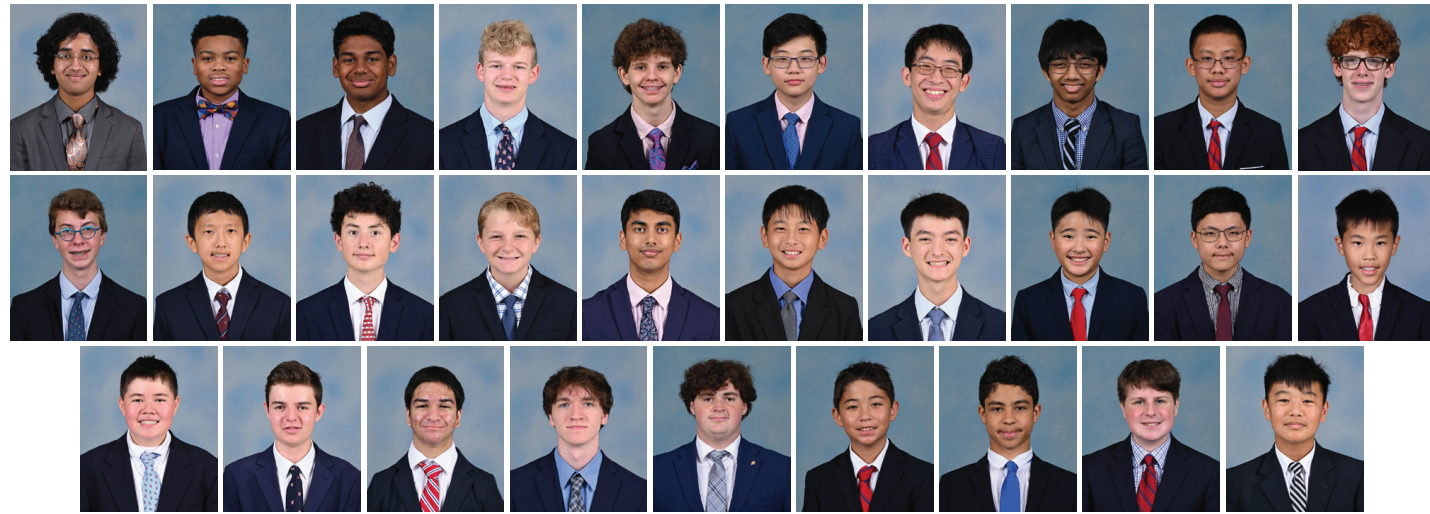
